Project Information

The Council District 3 Streetbox Project has been made possible with the support of Councilmember Bob Blumenfield. This Project transforms 25 utility boxes into works of art.

Artist Compensation and Commitment

Chosen designs/artists will be provided a stipend of **\$750 USD** to complete their works of public art and maintain the integrity of the work for a period of 2 years. Artists will be responsible for all of the necessary materials required for preparation, completion and maintenance of the artwork. All artwork will be anti graffiti coated after mural installation.

Theme

ROOTS & RESILIENCE: A Love Letter to the San Fernando Valley

Native Land & Indigenous Legacy

The San Fernando Valley is the ancestral home of the Tongva people, whose deep relationship with this land stretches back thousands of years. Artists are invited to honor that foundation – the original stewardship, knowledge, and presence that precedes everything else built here.

History & Foundation

Reseda, Canoga Park, and Winnetka each carry their own story – shaped by waves of migration, the postwar boom, and the communities that planted themselves here and stayed. Artists are encouraged to explore the people, places, and moments that gave these neighborhoods their identity.

Community Care & Mutual Aid

The Valley's strength lives in the everyday acts of looking out for one another – the mutual aid networks, community gardens, neighborhood icons, and small businesses that became anchors, and the hands that reach out during hard times. Artists are invited to celebrate the unglamorous, beautiful work of caring for a place and its people.

Resilience

The Valley has been tested – by earthquakes, economic hardship, displacement, raids, and fire. Again and again, it is the people who carry it through. We are looking for work that reflects the spirit of those who stay, rebuild, and choose community over and over again.

Eligibility

- This project is open to all artists in the Greater Los Angeles area.
- Designs by artists who live or work in Canoga Park, Reseda, or Winnetka will be given priority.
- Streetbox encourages applications from both emerging and professional artists.
- Artists may apply as individuals or as a group.
- Group submissions may be for a single utility box or multiple utility boxes.

Selection Process & Criteria

Submissions will be reviewed by a selection committee consisting of Streetbox curators, community members, and City representatives. Once the artwork is selected, 11:11 will send a notification by email and formal letter and the artist(s) will be assigned the City utility box(es).

Criteria used to select artists will be:

- Evaluation of artistic excellence including quality of the art and artist originality
- Creative and innovative concepts in relationship to the theme
- Appropriate regard for the nature of the space and the audience

A note on rendering quality: The selection committee evaluates your submission based on the render you provide. Your render must be legible, detailed, and reflect as closely as possible what would actually appear on the box. Do not assume that a rough or incomplete render will be interpreted generously – the quality and clarity of your rendering is part of how your skill as an artist is assessed. Submissions that do not clearly communicate the intended final artwork may not be considered.

Specifications

Streetbox Art is designed to encourage community pride and beautify the neighborhood. Streetbox Art will be installed in a public place and must be suitable for viewing by all ages. If your design is chosen, the artwork submitted in this application will be the artwork painted on the utility box. Designs may not change without a new rendering being submitted and approved.

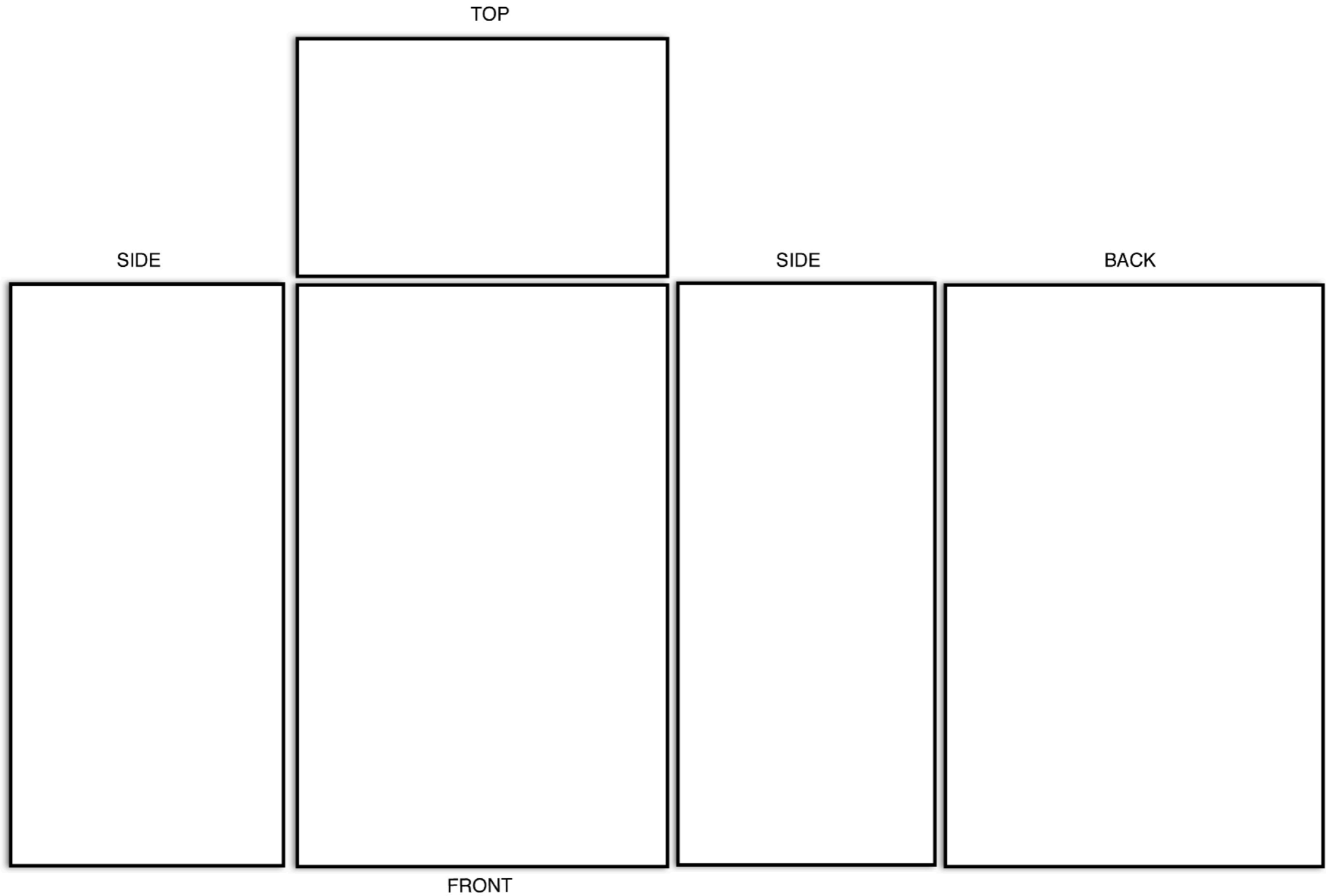
A Proposal will be ineligible for any one or more of the following reasons:

- It is not submitted on the template
- It contains a copyrighted or trademarked image or logo, or a brand or business name
- It is plagiarized, stolen, or copied from another source
- It defames or invades the rights of any person, living or dead
- It is likely to incite or produce an imminent lawless act
- It is integral to criminal conduct or violates the law
- It requires collage work or anything to be glued onto the box
- It may reasonably be construed as false or fraudulent; obscene matter as defined in California Penal Code Section 311 or any successor legislation; or harmful matter for minors as defined in California Penal Code Section 313 or any successor legislation
